### **LEGAL FOUNDATION**

#### 2. California Statutory and Case Law

- California Health & Safety Code §§ 120325–120380 (SB 277): While removing personal and religious exemptions for school vaccines, these statutes recognize medical exemptions and do not supersede parental rights to informed consent for medical procedures.
- **California Family Code § 6900-6910**: Confirms the authority of parents to consent or withhold consent to medical treatment for their minor children.
- California Constitution Article I, § 1: Enshrines the right to privacy and bodily autonomy.
- California Code of Regulations Title 17 § 6020: Requires immunization records but does not authorize the administration of vaccines without consent.

#### 3. Federal Statutory and Ethical Protections

- National Childhood Vaccine Injury Act of 1986 (42 U.S.C. § 300aa–1): Establishes a legal framework for vaccine-related injuries and affirms the right to informed consent.
- 42 U.S.C. § 1983 (Civil Rights Violations): Provides a cause of action against state actors who violate federally protected rights, including unauthorized medical interventions.

- Universal Declaration on Bioethics and Human Rights (UNESCO, 2005): Article 6 states that any preventive, diagnostic, or therapeutic intervention is only to be carried out with the prior, free, and informed consent of the person concerned.
- **Declaration of Geneva (World Medical Association)**: Establishes the physician's duty to respect patient autonomy and dignity.

### SCIENTIFIC EVIDENCE SUPPORTING REFUSAL

We assert that current scientific evidence demonstrates that **high vaccination rates do not** guarantee prevention of outbreaks and may, in some cases, facilitate viral transmission and mutation, thereby increasing public health risks.

- Guerra FM et al. (2017). "The basic reproduction number (R0) of measles: A systematic review." The Lancet Infectious Diseases, 17(12), e420–e428. Findings indicate measles outbreaks have occurred in populations with greater than 95% vaccination coverage.
- Rosen JB et al. (2014). "Outbreak of measles among persons with prior evidence of immunity, New York City, 2011." Clinical Infectious Diseases, 58(9), 1205–1210. The index case of a significant measles outbreak was a vaccinated individual; outbreak spread among vaccinated populations.
- Haber P et al. (2015). "Mumps outbreaks in vaccinated populations United States, 2006–2015." MMWR, 64(48), 1345–1349. Documented multiple mumps outbreaks in highly vaccinated populations.
- Kennedy DA & Read AF (2017). "Why does drug resistance readily evolve but vaccine resistance does not?" Proceedings of the Royal Society B, 284(1851), 20162562.

Mass vaccination exerts evolutionary pressures on pathogens, which can drive viral mutation and resistance.

• Lewnard JA & Grad YH (2018). "Vaccine waning and mumps resurgence in the United States." Science Translational Medicine, 10(433), eaao5945. Highlights waning immunity as a major contributor to outbreaks, even in highly vaccinated groups.

## **DEMANDS AND DECLARATIONS**

We hereby:
