LEGAL FOUNDATION

1. U.S. Constitutional Protections

2. Mississippi Statutory and Case Law

- Miss. Code Ann. § 41-23-37: Requires vaccinations for school entry; allows only medical exemptions signed by a licensed physician and approved by the Mississippi State Department of Health. However, this does not negate the constitutional requirement for informed consent or parental rights protected under federal law.
- **Mississippi Constitution**: Upholds the right to life, liberty, and due process, encompassing bodily autonomy and parental decision-making.
- **Case Law**: Mississippi courts recognize parental rights under the **U.S. Constitution** but have permitted state public health authority to impose school vaccine mandates. However, **non-mandated newborn interventions** such as Vitamin K and Hep B remain fully within parental discretion absent immediate threat to life.

3. Federal Statutory and Ethical Protections

- National Childhood Vaccine Injury Act of 1986 (42 U.S.C. § 300aa–1): Establishes the legal right to informed consent and mechanisms for vaccine injury compensation.
- 42 U.S.C. § 1983 (Civil Rights Violations): Provides recourse for violations of federally protected rights, including unauthorized medical treatment.

Current scientific evidence establishes that **high vaccination rates do not guarantee protection from outbreaks**, and may contribute to **viral transmission, mutation, and persistence**.

- Roberts JR et al. (2020). "Outbreaks of varicella in schools with high vaccination coverage." Pediatrics, 145(4), e20192307. Varicella (chickenpox) outbreaks occurred in highly vaccinated school populations, indicating limitations in vaccine effectiveness.
- Haber P et al. (2015). "Mumps outbreaks in vaccinated populations United States, 2006–2015." MMWR, 64(48), 1345–1349. Mumps outbreaks were linked to vaccinated individuals, illustrating transmission despite compliance with vaccine mandates.
- Guerra FM et al. (2017). "The basic reproduction number (R0) of measles: A systematic review." The Lancet Infectious Diseases, 17(12), e420–e428. Measles outbreaks occurred in populations with vaccination coverage exceeding 95%, indicating vaccine limitations.
