#### LEGAL FOUNDATION

We, the undersigned parents and legal guardians of [Child's Name], acting pursuant to the United States Constitution, the New Jersey Constitution, federal statutes, and binding international legal and ethical frameworks, hereby assert and exercise our absolute, constitutionally protected rights to refuse participation in school vaccine mandates and other medical interventions, including but not limited to Hepatitis B vaccine, Vitamin K injection, MMR, DTaP, varicella, polio, and all other school-required vaccinations.

#### 1. U.S. Constitutional Protections

#### **DEMANDS AND DECLARATIONS**

We hereby:

- State unequivocally that any attempt to administer vaccines or other medical treatments to our child without explicit parental consent constitutes unlawful medical battery and a violation of civil rights, enforceable under federal and state law.
