LEGAL FOUNDATION

1. U.S. Constitutional Protections

2. Washington State Statutory and Case Law

- **RCW 28A.210.090:** Allows medical and religious exemptions for school vaccinations, but philosophical exemptions were removed for MMR in 2019.
- RCW 7.70.050: Requires informed consent for healthcare decisions.
- RCW 26.09.184 and Case Law (Troxel v. Granville): Parents have a fundamental right to make healthcare decisions for their child.

• Interpretation: Despite strict school mandates, informed consent statutes uphold parental authority for non-mandated newborn interventions, such as Vitamin K and Hepatitis B.

- National Childhood Vaccine Injury Act of 1986 (42 U.S.C. § 300aa–1): Establishes the necessity of informed consent and provides for vaccine injury compensation.
